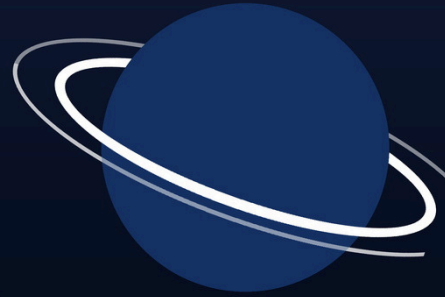

The Basics



Funds:

Instructional resources, professional learning, student engagement, AI curriculum expansion.



Eligibility:

Funding will be distributed to local education agencies (LEAs) through a competitive, need-based grant process



Amount:

Each LEA may request up to \$20,000 in funding

Open Sept. 1



Proposals due Sept 25



Awards ~ Oct. 5th

Vertical Alignment

Demonstrating vertical alignment will help you have a stronger application

02

Prove Your Impact

Demonstrated need and quality of implementation plan will be key scoring points

03

Vendor-Specific

The grant asks which vendor you are partnering with and allows for one partner

What the Grant **Can** Fund:

One **specified** computer science/AI digital curriculum



One professional development or certification package



Purchases from a **single** vendor



Skill Struck Can Provide:

State-aligned CS/AI curriculum

Full PD for AI, CS, and implementation

Partnership with dedicated support

What the Grant **Can't** Fund



Hardware of any kind: devices, printers, drones, recording or A/V equipment



More than one curriculum, software, or PD item on a single application



Purchases a district doesn't have the technology infrastructure to support yet
